
## Early WVU Psychologists (1921-1962)

This table contains the names of all psychologists on the faculty at West Virginia University from 1921, when the first psychologist was hired, to 1962, when the Department of Psychology moved into Oglebay Hall.

These psychologists were members of the Department of Philosophy and Psychology that was located in Woodburn Hall during most of this time,
except for a few years in the 1930s when the department was located in the Old Library (now Stewart Hall).



Department doctoral program was created in 1963 and existing faculty comprised two focal areas: (a) Teaching of General Psychology and (b) Clinical Service

b = 5 faculty members affiliated with Clinical Service Psychology area
