All students admitted to the doctoral graduate program are offered a graduate assistantship that qualifies them for waiver of university tuition in addition to a minimum 9-mo stipend of \$15,400 and student health insurance. Students are required to pay university/institution fees. The total benefit for 4 years of graduate study (stipend + university tuition waiver + health insurance) granted to each student in the program by WVU exceeds \$161,000.
